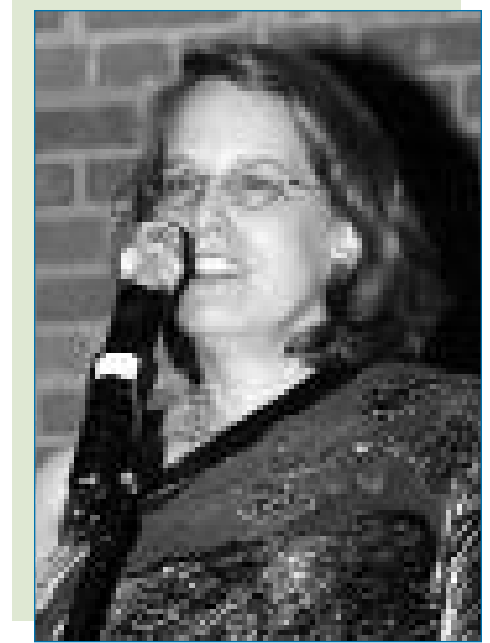

A few weeks ago I was looking for a file in my office and came across a box of odd papers and newspaper clippings. Of course I stopped to look at it, and in the bottom I found a three page report signed by Margaret Nygard and dated October 10, 1971. It was entitled “Activities on the Eno, 1970–71” and I expect it was a report she prepared for the Annual Meeting that year. The entire document is interesting, but what struck me the most was the last paragraph, which I think embodies the spirit of the Eno River Association just as much today as it did in 1971. I want to read you just a few sentences.

WHEREAS, the Eno River Association was founded in 1966 with a mission of conserving and protecting the natural, cultural, and historic resources of the Eno River basin; and

WHEREAS, the Association's efforts over the past four decades have resulted in more than 5,000 acres of protected land; and

WHEREAS, those protected lands include five public parks: the Eno River State Park; the Little River Regional Park; the Occochee Mountain State Natural Area; Penny's Bend Nature Preserve; and the West Point on the Eno City of Durham Park; and

WHEREAS, the Association also engages in a variety of other activities, including environmental education; advocacy for responsible development; winter, spring, and New Year's Day hikes; and

WHEREAS, the Association has produced the Festival for the Eno for 28 years, achieving national renown and becoming one of the premier events in the entire state, attracting more than 70,000 people to West Point Park annually; and

WHEREAS, the Association has set the worthy goal of acquiring the remaining 2,000 acres of designated parklands; and

WHEREAS, the Association is celebrating its 40 years of service to the community and to the environment.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, William V. "Bill" Bell, Mayor of the City of Durham, North Carolina do hereby proclaim Saturday, February 3, 2007 as

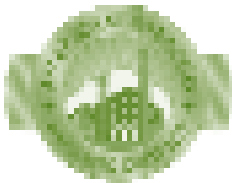

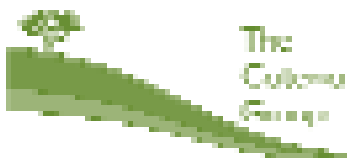

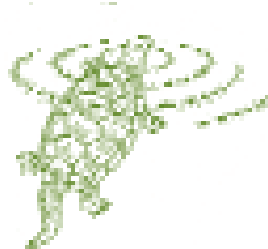
